

# CHÂTEAU PEYROS

MADIRAN

## HISTORY

- ❖ The property was built in the XVIIth century, and Jean Jacques Lesgourgues took over it in 1999.
- ❖ « *Peyros* » means a stony place in Gascony language, which is representative of the terroir
- ❖ The vineyard got the Terra Vitis and HVE certification in 2018

## VINEYARD

- ❖ 20 hectares of vines for the southernmost vineyard of Madiran appellation
- ❖ 8 hectares are used for Tannat-Cabernet grape variety
- ❖ Terroir : rolled pebbles and intermediate Graves on a clay-silty soil.
- ❖ Average age of the vines: from 25 to 30 years old
- ❖ Yield: 42hl/ha
- ❖ Production : 36 000 bottles

## GRAPE VARIETY

- ❖ 60% Tannat - 40% Cabernet Franc

## VINIFICATION

- ❖ Traditional in inox tank
- ❖ Pellicular fermentation: 20 days
- ❖ Ageing: 12 mois avec 20% de fûts neufs

## AGEING POTENTIAL

From 10 to 15 years

## TASTING NOTES

- ❖ Deep and intense ruby-red color.
  - ❖ The nose is fully-expressive, with black fruits, typical of Tannat.
- Round on the palate, unctuous and supple. The wine reveals subtle notes of cherry with a great freshness and a length on the palate.

## GOURMET INSTANT

- ❖ To pair with roasted meat (lamb, beef) or or slightly spicy tartars.
- ❖ A cuvée which reveals the full potential of Madiran appellation.
