HISTORY

- ❖ The property was built in the XVIIth century and Jean Jacques Lesgourgues took over it in 1999
- ❖ « *Peyros* » means a stony place in Gascony language, which is representative of this exceptional terroir
- ❖ The 20 hectare vineyard got the Terra Vitis and HVE certification in 2018

VINEYARD

- ❖ 20 hectares of vines for the southernmost vineyard of Madiran appellation
- ❖ 1,2 hectares with southern exposure below the Greenwich Meridian for this cuvée
- ❖ Average age of vines : from 40 to 50 years old
- ❖ Yield : 26hl/ha

GRAPE VARIETY

- ❖ 100% Tannat

VINIFICATION

- ❖ Traditional in a 'plot tank'
- ❖ Fermentation of 25 days
- ❖ Malolactic fermentation in french oak french barrel
- ❖ Ageing 18 months of new barrels

AGEING POTENTIAL

Until 25 years old

TASTING NOTES

- ❖ The nose is fully-expressive, both minty and peppery complemented by notes of black fruits. On the palate, this wine is open, powerful and unctuous. This wine reveals some fruity and spicy aromas with some licorice notes. Long on the palate, with supple tanins for well balanced and powerful wine.

GOURMET INSTANT

- ❖ To pair with meat such as duck, game (venison, salmi de palombe) or a dark chocolate cake.
- ❖ To decant before serving.
