VIEILLES VIGNES 2018

HISTORY

- ❖ The property was built in the XVIIIth century, and Jean Jacques Lesgourgues took over it in 1999.
- ❖ « *Peyros* » means a stony place in Gascony language, which is representative of the terroir
- ❖ The vineyard got the Terra Vitis and HVE certification in 2018

VINEYARD

- ❖ 20 hectares of vines for the southernmost vineyard of Madiran appellation
- ❖ 6,5 hectares for the Vieilles Vignes cuvée, rolled pebbles and intermediate Graves on a clay-silty soil.
- ❖ Average age of vines: 35 years old
- ❖ Yield: 32hl/ha / Production : 26.753 bottles

GRAPE VARIETIES

- ❖ 80% Tannat
- ❖ 20% Cabernet Franc

VINIFICATION

- ❖ Traditional in stainless still tanks (20 days)
- ❖ Ageing in 12 months one third of new barrels (225L and 500L) of Allary, Gillet and Saury

AGEING POTENTIAL

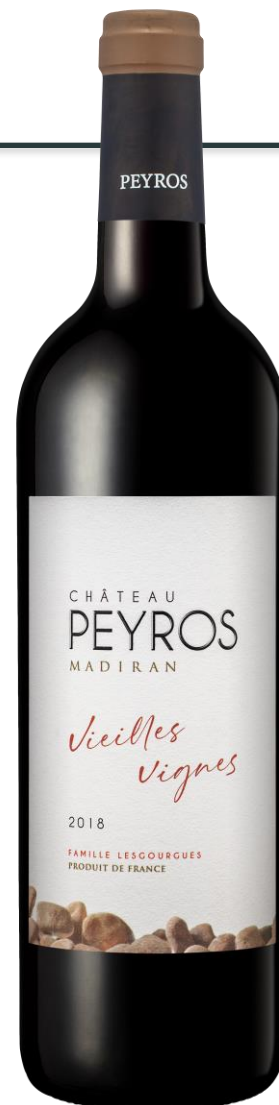
- ❖ From 12 to 15 years

TASTING NOTES

- ❖ Dark color with intense ruby-red reflects.
 - ❖ The nose is fully-expressive with dark and red fruits notes completed by a nice woody notes.
 - ❖ On the palate, this wine is very aromatic, round and supple.
- The freshness takes over in the middle of the mouth, to finish on melted and coated tannins which support the length. The balance is there for a wine that is both powerful and elegant.

GOURMET INSTANT

- ❖ To pair with roasted meats (lamb, beef), meats in sauce, spicy tartars, duck breast.
